## Can These Questions Be Answered??

If I have a **HANDICAP** license plate, can I convert it to a RLP? Since only one graphic is allowed per license plate, if one chooses to receive the handicapped benefits while displaying the RLP emblem, one must hang a placard on their rear view mirror inside of their car.

Since my **COMMERCIAL** plates have seven letters, can I get a Rotary Commercial License Plate? The answer is YES. The DMV has commercial plates for us to be used on our commercial vehicles with SIX letters and the Rotary wheel. Submit those applications!

Can **ONLY ROTARIANS** buy RLP's? No, these plates are for anyone that supports the work that Rotary does, but for some reason, can not be a Rotarian. Think of your spouse, your children, your friends, your Rotary event supporters, Interactors, and your church members,
